

DBIS Scholarship Programme

IBDP 2024-25

Scholarships may be presented in the three percentages of the annual school fee: **25% or 50%** depending upon the evaluated '**eligibility**' of an applicant. The scholarship will be awarded only on the tuition fees, it will not be applicable to Text books, Examination fees, CAS trip, Laptop, Calculator and other expenses incurred during the two years of the IBDP programme .

***Academic Scholarship: ‘Minimum Eligibility Criterion’**

The students who have persistently achieved high academic grades/scores and are interested in applying for scholarship. To be eligible to apply, students must meet the following **‘Minimum Eligibility Criterion’** in grade 10.

Curriculum	Minimum Eligibility Criterion
CBSE	Achievement grade that translates into a CGPA of 9.0 or 95 % and above.

ICSE and SSC	95% and above.
IGCSE	Minimum 5 A* and not more than one C
MYP	48 and above out of 56 with a MYP Certificate

****Points to Note**

- The applications for the scholarships for the categories: School topper/s and Academics should be made post the declaration of the Board results.
- The school management may roll out the scholarship offers within a month of the Board result declaration.
- The first instalment of the fees needs to be paid before the scholarship decision and as per the stipulated deadline.
- The students who have been offered the DBIS scholarship need to maintain good academic grades in IBDP Year 1 to be eligible for the scholarship in IBDP Year 2. The school management would review each individual scholarship offer at the end of IBDP Year 1 before offering the continuum scholarship in the IBDP Year 2.
- The Management's decision on the scholarship offer would be final.
